"Wide spread disease outbreak since the beginning of second quarter has impacted shrimp production in our markets and thereby affected feed sales. Also the Margins for the period remained under pressure owing to the increase in the raw material prices.

The processing and export operations of the company resumed in this quarter, after a very long gap. Onetime expenses incurred to re-start the operations and spurt in the farm gate prices of shrimps procured for exports too affected the results for the quarter.



We are pleased to be recognized for product innovation by Frost & Sullivan during the quarter. The most heartening aspect is that we are judged on basis of several parameters, which involved in depth interviews with various industry participants and secondary research conducted by Frost & Sullivan analysts.
